

2017-2018 Options for Faith Formation

Liturgical Catechesis following Children's Liturgy of the Word

Begins 9/17/17 during 10am Mass

Pre-K (4 years old) & Kindergarten: Children will come downstairs for the readings & then return to Mass after they have completed the Liturgy of the Word. *No registration fee is needed for this age group.*

For children in Grades 1 – 3

Liturgical Catechesis is being offered to children in grades 1-3 following the Liturgy of the Word for Children. Parents will bring their child to 10am Mass and during the introductory rite, Father will call the children forward, give them a blessing, and send them off to worship in a simpler way with a volunteer Minister of the Word.

Children will NOT return to Mass, parents pick them up in the hall after Mass.

Schedule of class dates will be given on the first day.

Traditional Model – For children in Grades 1 - 8

Saturdays from 9-10:15am (Begins 9/16/17)

Meets weekly September – April follows the school year calendar with holiday breaks.

Schedule of class dates will be given on the first day.

Traditional Model – For teenagers in Grades 9 & 10

Sunday mornings from 11am-Noon (Begins 9/17/17 – Helping @ Donut Sunday)

Parent/Teen meetings (date TBA) will be held to explain the 9th grade & 10th grade programs.

You will receive a notice for the meeting dates.

Schedules with class dates will be handed out at meetings.

Intergenerational Model for the whole family, Grades 1 - Adult

Each session includes a meal along with program and is a 3-hour commitment once a month from October through April on a Sunday afternoon.

Dates: Oct 1, Nov 5, Dec 3, Jan 7, Feb 4, Mar 4, and Apr 8 from 1-4pm

Because there are only 7 sessions for the year, attendance at each session is crucial. If you have conflicts on a regular basis with these dates, please choose another Faith Formation Option for your family.

Sacraments

Sacramental preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation will be done separately from the faith formation classes. Information on sacramental preparation will be given at a later date to families that are directly involved.
